Halloween makeovers from £35

Prosthetic and SFX from £45

Small scars/burns from £35

SFX commissions

Studio day rate from £350 for up to six hours

Please note: liquid latex, third degree, prosthetic adhesive and spirit gum are used in the majority of the halloween looks. You will be asked to complete an allergy form before your makeover can take place.







FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Can you recreate a look for me?

If you have a certain look in mind, please send me an email with a picture attachment first – I'll take a look and be able to give you an answer. Most of my Halloween looks that I offer are shown in my Halloween album on my Facebook page along with the prices for each look.

How long does a Halloween look take?

It all completely depends on the look – if we need to use liquid latex and spirit gum, it's important that we allow plenty of time for the materials to dry. Some looks may take an hour, some may take four hours. Once you know what kind of look you'd like, I can give you a time estimate.

Do you travel out for Halloween makeovers?

Usually, no. Halloween makeup is messy and requires adequate space to lay everything out. I tend to work from a studio with a floor that I can easily wipe clean – spirit gum and liquid latex wouldn't fare well on a carpet in a home!

When should I book?

Halloween is my busiest time of year and sometimes, I can be booked months if not a year ahead. As with any makeover, Halloween makeovers require a 50% booking fee of the total cost to secure your date and time.

How much do Halloween makeovers cost?

The cost varies from look to look, please see my Facebook album for individual costs of the looks that I offer.

How long will my makeup last?

Prosthetic makeup is pretty hardy and should last until you choose to remove it. If looked after properly, your makeup will last for the full day/evening.

Can I bring my child along to my appointment?

No. As the studio is a working environment with industrial equipment, we do not welcome children. Please arrange childcare beforehand if needed.





Terms and Conditions

- 1). All clients are required to sign a contract and allergy form. Without a signed form, the makeover will not go ahead.
- 2). A 50% non refundable and non returnable booking fee is required to secure all appointments at the time of booking, for special occasion makeovers, the remaining balance is payable on the day in cash or before the day by direct bank transfer with no exceptions. For bridal clients, the full amount must be paid upfront 30 days before the wedding date with no exceptions.
- 3). If a client cancels or misses an appointment, they will not be refunded for their booking fee.
- 4). Clients who are more than ten minutes late may be unable to go ahead with their appointment and will not be refunded for their booking fee.
- 5). A travel fee will apply to all mobile makeovers which will be 45p per mile from S72 8PY.
- 6). Mobile makeovers are only available to bookings for two or more clients.
- 7). Where parking valet or toll fees may be incurred on mobile appointments, the amount will be factored into the final invoice and due for payment on or before the day of the event.

- 8). The location of the service will be in studio. In the case of a mobile makeover, there are certain requirements the makeup artist needs to complete the makeup application. A "set up" table/work area needs to be made available for the makeup artist at said location along with ample lighting in order for the services to be performed properly.
- 9). Makeovers before 8am will be subject to an early fee of £25 for every hour before 8am.
- 10). Makeup will be completed to the client's satisfaction, but is not to exceed the allotted makeover appointment. Acceptance of completed makeup application by the client is acknowledgment by the client that the makeover has been completed to their satisfaction.
- 11). All brushes and makeup products are kept sanitary and are sanitized between every makeup application. Makeup products used are hypoallergenic. Any skin condition or allergy should be reported by the client to the makeup artist prior to application of the makeup. By signing the aforementioned contract, clients agree to release the makeup artist (Rachael Divers of Rachael Divers Makeup Artistry) from liability for any skin complications or allergic reactions.
- 12). Cancellations must be made 14 days prior to your reserved date, otherwise you will be responsible for the full amount of services agreed upon in this contract.
